San Diego Fire-Rescue and CAL FIRE/San Diego County Fire Authority are working together to provide temporary fire station housing for the CAL FIRE crew at Station 38. Station 38 is located near the George Bailey Detention Center in Otay Mesa. Currently Station 38 is in a temporary facility that has been designated to be replaced with a new fire station. During construction of the new station the crew will be placed at San Diego Fire-Rescue Station 43 with Engine 43's crew.

The CAL FIRE crew of four (captain, engineer, one firefighter and one medic firefighter) will cross staff a quint aerial ladder truck and a Type III brush apparatus. The CAL FIRE crews will work the CAL FIRE 72/96 "Bump" schedule. Two shifts will rotate on a 72 hour on and 96 hour off schedule with a "Fixed" relief crew that will pick up the 7th day. The Station 38 crew will continue to respond to incidents within their own district from Fire Station 43. They will also provide additional response support within the Battalion 6.

CAL FIRE/San Diego County Fire Authority is providing logistical support with new mattresses, tables, chairs, refrigerators, washer and dryer for Fire Station 43. Emergency Operations and the Logistics Division are working closely with CAL FIRE/San Diego County Fire Authority personnel on the details of the agreement. The anticipated start date will June 2017.
