SUBJECT: New Hygenall Decontamination Products

The Occupational Health & Safety Committee (OHSC) evaluated and recommended the additional products to support our Department's Cancer Awareness and Prevention Program (CAPP). In partnership and with the support of the Logistics Division, additional decontamination supplies were purchased for all SDFD Fire and BSU apparatus and facilities.

The assortment of Hygenall products will allow better exposure reduction capabilities. Hygenall Scrub and Field Wash give more options to removing contaminants from absorbing into our skin, and Hygenall Tox-Off Spray will remove more chemicals from apparatus cab interiors. These items will significantly improve our long-term health and safety.

As a reminder to the workforce, reducing the number of chemicals exposed will reduce our toxic load throughout our fire service career. The overall goal is to create a healthier environment and reduce our risk for cancer and other diseases.

The Hood Exchange Kit has been renamed the **Personal Decontamination and Hydration Kit** (green or black bag). When making replacement orders utilize PSTrax under the new name.

Logistics staff has distributed the new products to be added to the Personal Decontamination and Hydration Kits and the fire stations. (See the updated Personal Decontamination and Hydration Kit Inventory attachment). Personal Decontamination and Hydration Kits have been distributed and added to the Type III apparatus inventories.

The Tox-Off spray and FieldWash foaming soap are new station items. All stations will be provided a 1-gallon FieldWash refill. Use of these decontamination items is strictly for personal decontamination after fire incidents.
