**SUBJECT:** SuccessFactors Learning for Citywide Training

All Fire/Rescue Department employees have been assigned a SuccessFactors Learning (SFL) account which must now be used to complete required City-wide training. The use of SFL by all City employees is essential to maintain tracking and reporting consistency for Citywide training initiatives.

SFL will be used solely for Citywide training. We will continue to use Target Solutions for department-specific training.

As background, SAP SuccessFactors Learning is the City's Learning Management System for Citywide learning needs and resources.

Through SuccessFactors Learning, employees can:

- Search course catalogs to register for Citywide courses such as Supervisors Academy, Appointing Authority Interview, or Discipline and Rewards training
- Launch e-learning courses
- View their Citywide training history
