SUBJECT: New iPads Assigned to Fire Operations via EMS Contract

New iPads have been assigned to all frontline first responder units for the primary purpose of ePCR documentation via the "StreetEMS" ePCR application. These tablets are provided under the EMS Agreement by Falck Ambulance which began medical transportation services on November 27th, 2021. In addition to the ePCR application, there are a variety of additional mobile applications loaded to these devices assigned to first responders. Requests for technical support for these devices could fall into (2) different areas of responsibility, based upon problem(s) and the application of concern.

The first stop for any request for technical support shall always be the City IT Help Desk which can be reached via **x65999** or **877-796-5999**. The IT Help Desk will be provided sufficient direction to immediately solve or assign the appropriate agency (SDFD IT versus Falck) based on your description. For your awareness, in general terms:

- 1. All ePCR related issues (StreetEMS) including password issues, registration of device, software bugs, etc. would be directed to Falck.
- 2. iPad device (hardware) issues such as broken, loss, operating system (iOS problems), cellular connectivity, are the responsibility of Falck.
- 3. Fire-Rescue IT will continue to support issues concerning applications such as:
 - a. Street Fire RMS
 - b. Tablet Command Mobile
 - c. Intterra
 - d. PSTrax
 - e. Streamline Inspections
 - f. SimsUShare
 - g. SDFD Radios
 - h. SDFD Maps
 - i. Smartsheet Forms
 - j. Telestaff
 - k. Vector Solutions

As already stated, the required and most expeditious process to follow is to generate a City IT Help Desk ticket which will lead to the appropriate assignment of any support need. Please direct any questions to your chain of command regarding this guidance.
