SUBJECT:	Minor Injury Report – RM-1568 (Rev 4-15)

The Minor Injury Report, form RM-1568 (Rev 4-15), is used to record any minor work-related injury or illness (e.g. cuts, bruises, strains, bumps) that do NOT require medical treatment.

The Minor Injury Report is a citywide form that can be located on the City's intranet at <u>https://citynet.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/minorinjuryrpt.pdf</u> and is titled "Minor Injury, Report of."

A sample of form RM-1568 (Rev 4-15) is attached for reference. The form should be filled out completely by the employee and their immediate supervisor within 24 hours of the time of injury.

## **Supervisors Instructions:**

- Complete the Minor Injury Report *within* 24-*hours* of the time of injury.
- Ensure both the Supervisor and Employee Signature and Date fields are complete.
- Provide the employee a copy of the completed report for their records.
- Submit the original via interoffice mail to Angelica Guzman at MS-604.
- To ensure delivery, a copy can also be emailed to <u>AGuzman@sandiego.gov</u>.
- Do **NOT** send copies to Risk Management. Employee Services maintains a copy in the employee's medical file.

For injuries or illnesses that require medical treatment, employees must complete the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department Injury Report packet (blue envelope).
