SUSPECTED DEPENDENT ADULT AND ELDER ABUSE/NEGLECT REPORTING

JANUARY 10, 2024

When Suspected Dependent Adult and Elder Abuse/Neglect reporting is required, personnel can now access San Diego County EMS Form SOC341 from the iPad through StreetEMS. To access the form, select the "..." icon located on the bottom right corner of the Home Page. Then, select "links" and the page shown below will appear. Tap on the appropriate link and the form will appear, a username and password are no longer needed to access and submit this form.

However, when accessing Form SS8572 - Suspicion of Child Abuse/Neglect, you may be required to create a login if you have not done so in the past.
