I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this policy is to provide Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) and Paramedics (PMs) with a regularly scheduled continuing education curriculum and preparation for EMS Skills testing.

II. <u>SCOPE</u>

This policy shall apply to all sworn San Diego Fire-Rescue Department (SDFD) personnel, excluding Lifeguard personnel.

III <u>AUTHORITY</u>

The Fire Chief authorizes this policy.

IV. <u>POLICY</u>

- A. <u>Description</u>
 - 1. The Battalion Medical Officer (BMO) program is the Department's decentralized Emergency Medical Services (EMS) training program, conducted on a routine basis within each battalion and division. BMOs are assigned to each battalion and division, as well as straight-day and light-duty personnel.

B. <u>Responsibility</u>

1. The BMO program is the responsibility of the EMS Division.

C. <u>Attendance</u>

- 1. Attendance is mandatory for all EMTs and PMs.
 - i. Immediate supervisors are directly responsible for the attendance of assigned personnel, including straight-day and light-duty assignments.
 - ii. If there is a scheduling conflict or an expected absence during a BMO session, personnel shall notify their supervisor.
 - iii. Relief personnel must monitor their own attendance and shall notify their supervisor of their need to attend the current BMO session.
- 2. BMOs will coordinate scheduled dates and times with their Battalion Chiefs (BCs).
 - i. BCs are responsible for providing the necessary relief within their area of jurisdiction to ensure all personnel have the opportunity to attend each training session.
- D. <u>Non-Attendance</u>

Personnel who fail to attend the BMO sessions may not have enough Continuing Education (CE) hours for their EMT or PM certification renewal which is a requirement for employment.

1. In the case of a missed BMO session due to injury or leave, the individual will contact their assigned BMO to coordinate a make-up session.
