SUBJECT: Water Tender Response Guidelines

Effective immediately, the following guidelines shall be utilized regarding dispatching and deployment of any San Diego Fire-Rescue (SDFD) water tender. SDFD water tenders will not be dispatched out-of-county. SDFD water tenders shall be dispatched and staffed in the following manners:

- 1. Initial Attack (In-Zone) within the Metro Zone
 - a. Certified and licensed firefighter or firefighter P/M will respond unaccompanied in order to expedite the response.
- 2. Immediate Need (Out-of-Zone) outside of the Metro Zone
 - a. Certified and licensed firefighter or firefighter P/M will respond with a captain. Preferably, the captain will be certified and licensed; however, it is not a requirement.
- 3. Planned Need (Out-of-Zone) outside of the Metro Zone
 - a. Certified and licensed firefighter or firefighter P/M will respond with a captain. Preferably, the captain will be certified and licensed; however, it is not a requirement.

In the event that an Initial Attack response is anticipated or extends past the first operational period or 12 hours, a captain will be added to the staffing of the water tender.

These response guidelines shall be incorporated into the Operations Manual.
