I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide procedures on beds and bedding in fire stations.

II. SCOPE

This policy applies to all sworn San Diego Fire-Rescue (SDFD) fire department personnel except lifeguards.

III. AUTHORITY

The fire chief authorizes the information in this policy.

IV. **POLICY**

A. Bedding Purchase

- 1. San Diego Fire-Rescue Department (SDFD) members shall purchase and maintain their own linens, to include pillow, pillowcase, sheets and blankets.
- 2. SDFD will provide bedspreads and bed bug bags for all beds.
- 3. Bedspreads shall be washed weekly on Sunday.
- 4. No personnel shall sleep on an uncovered mattress.
- 5. Mattresses shall be turned/flipped weekly and aired on Sundays by removing the bed spread.
- 6. Personnel shall ensure each mattress is fitted with an undamaged bed bug bag.

B. Off-Going Shift

The off-going shift shall leave the beds presentable, with a bedspread covering the mattress.

C. On-Duty Shift

The on-duty shift may make up their beds between 17:30 and 20:30 hours.
